During the process of material collection some important questions were found. Last months the partners started to train their workers with the final and defined collection guide and all is progressing very well.

The result of the collection of material are the first trials of the yarns, with very positive results and good quality.

The project has a huge potential to question and solve an important aspect in circular economy in the technical textile value chain.
